國際組織標案類型簡介

亞洲開發銀行 (ADB)

亞洲開發銀行(Asian Development Bank, ADB)創立於1966年，總部位於菲律賓馬尼拉，我國為創始會員國之一，其成立宗旨在協助亞太地區發展中會員國集體及個別之經濟加速發展，藉由提供貸款、技術援助、捐贈及股權投資，協助會員國與合作夥伴之經濟及社會發展，並設有「亞洲開發基金」(Asian Development Fund, ADF)協助低度開發之會員國消弭貧窮。

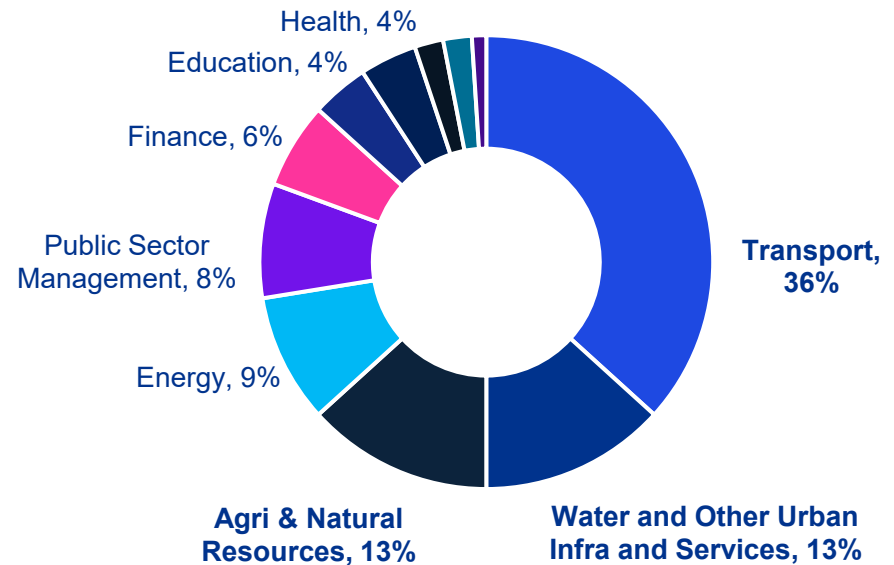
亞銀現有69個會員國，包括50個區域內(亞太地區)會員國及19個區域外會員國。理事會(Board of Governors)為亞銀最高權力機構，我國理事由財政部部長擔任，副理事則由中央銀行副總裁擔任。自2014年6月財政部接任ADB理事相關業務，歷年均由財政部部長率團出席ADB理事會年會，深化與ADB及其會員國經貿交流。

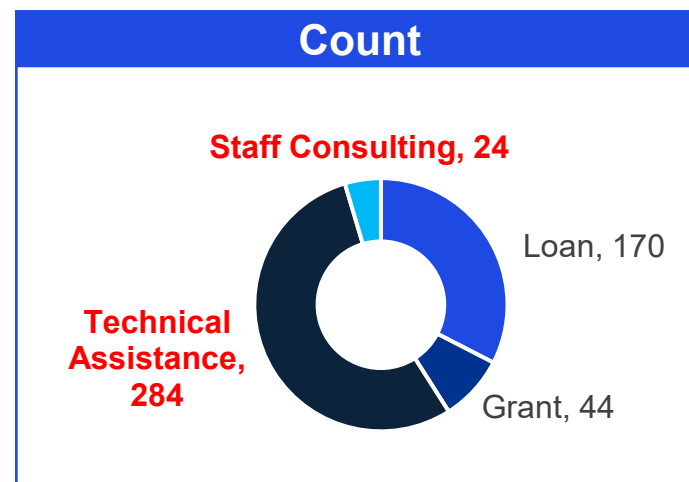
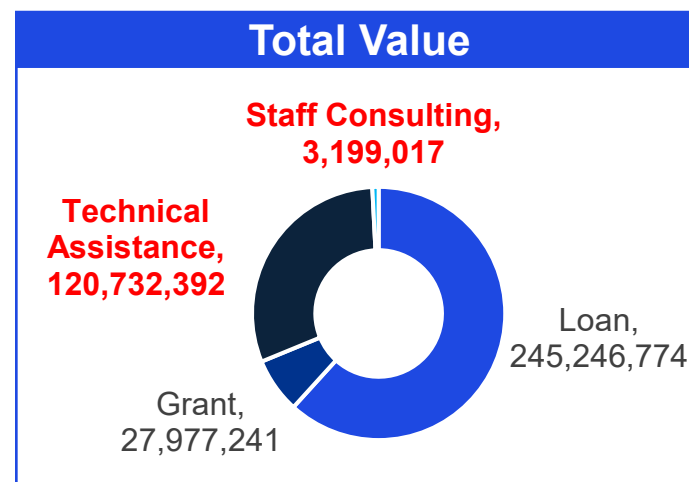

歐洲復興開發銀行 (European Bank for Reconstruction and Development, EBRD) 成立於1991年，總部設在英國倫敦，旨在協助推動中東歐、中亞、西亞及北非等地區受援國轉型為市場經濟，並邁向民主多元社會。

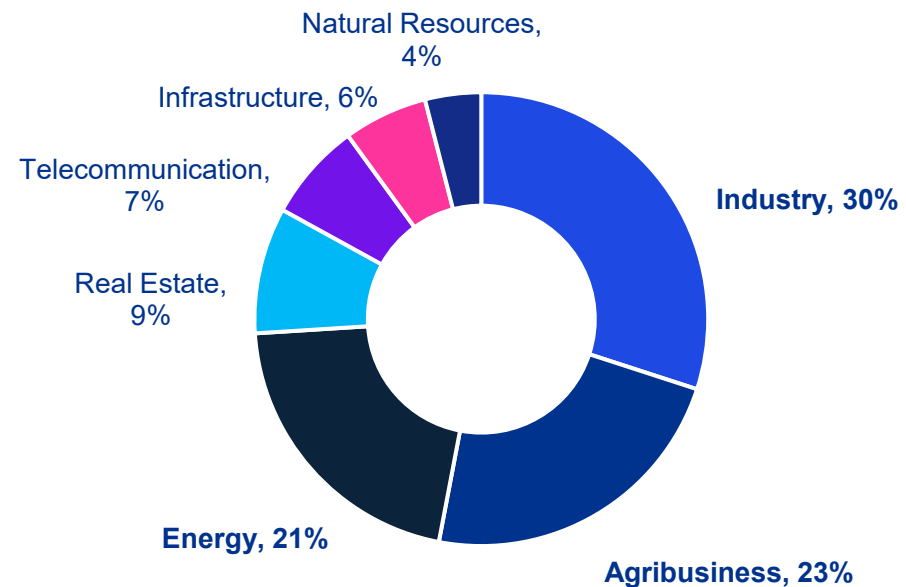
現有75個會員，其中包括38個受援國。我國以特別觀察員身分出席歐銀年會，並自1991年起在歐銀成立「臺灣—歐銀技術合作基金」，參與歐銀協助受援國轉型之合作計畫，財政部分別自2006年與2024年派員赴EBRD貿易促進計畫處(Trade Facilitation Programme, TFP)與聯貸處(Debt Mobilisation)工作，以利國際金融事務經驗交流，並積極協助我國廠商充分掌握EBRD釋出商機。

EBRD Consultancy Opportunities

Reasons to pursue EBRD-financed Consultant Contracts

- Participation enhances a consultant's reputation and visibility in the international development finance community
- Gain diverse and high-value opportunities (EBRD public sector clients signed 84 consultancy contracts worth €78 million in 2024)

Eligibility

世界銀行集團(WBG)

世界銀行集團 (World Bank Group, WBG) 是一個包含有5個國際組織的集團，包含國際復興開發銀行、國際開發協會、國際金融公司、多邊投資擔保機構、國際投資爭端解決中心。其中，國際復興開發銀行與國際開發協會常被合稱為「世界銀行」，其總部在美國華盛頓特區。

世界銀行是一個由各國政府組成的國際金融機構，它是聯合國的專門機構之一，擁有189個成員國旨在提供資金和專業技術支持來促進發展中國家的經濟成長。世界銀行集團成立於二戰末期（1944年），其最開始的使命是幫助在第二次世界大戰中被破壞的國家的重建。今天它的任務是「終結極度貧困，促進共享繁榮」。世界銀行集團通過向開發中國家提供低息貸款、無息信貸和贈款來資助這些國家克服窮困，各機構在減輕貧困和提高生活水平的使命中發揮獨特的作用。

Objective and Purpose of the Assignment

The Office of Market Development and Public-Private Partnership (OMDP), Asian Development Bank, is assisting Energy Fiji Limited ("EFL"), the generation and distribution services provider in Fiji, to develop various renewable energy generation projects including solar, wind and battery storage. These projects will be identified based on ADB's support and on EFL's priorities based on generation requirement, site suitability, evacuation facilities, etc. ("the Project") and are expected to total approximately 100-150MW (not including battery storage).

Initially, 4 project sites have been identified to be used as proof of concept for this purpose. The target sites are identified as below:

- (i) Monasavu Dam - for a potential floating solar PV generating facility combined with potential battery storage, in the center of Viti Levu island of Fiji.
- (ii) Butoni Wind farm – for a potential ground mounted solar PV generation facility on unutilized area of wind farm and an adjacent land parcel with potential battery storage, in western side of Viti Levu island, Fiji.
- (iii) Vaturu Dam – for a potential floating solar PV generating facility combined with potential battery storage, on the western side of Viti Levu island of Fiji.
- (iv) Additionally, EFL is willing to add one more site which will be identified before or during this study.

EFL has mandated the ADB to support in project identification, project preparation and implementation support:

- I. Project identification and definition: site screening of solar PV plants with battery storage, considering grid capacity constraints, proximity to load centers, environment and social aspects, amongst others.
- II. Project preparation: preparation of detailed site survey (geotechnical, hydrological etc.), legal due diligence and recommendations on amendments required in legal and regulatory framework, financial, technical, environmental, and climate change resilience and social diligence.
- III. Tendering and close: support in preparation of bid documents, managing the tender process end-to-end till signing of relevant contractual agreements by the private partner(s) with implementing/government agencies, and support to achieve financial close.

In this regard, ADB is procuring services of a technical advisor (firm) (the "Technical Advisor") to carry out all the technical works related to Phase I to III.

ADB Procurement Principle

Procurement Principles	Content
Economy	The principle of economy means taking into account factors such as price, quality, and any nonprice attributes, as appropriate, without adversely affecting the viability of the project.
Efficiency	The principle of efficiency ensures that procurement processes are proportional to the value and risks of the required outcome and underlying project activities, taking into account implementation capacity, time constraints, and cost-effectiveness.
Fairness	The principle of fairness means (a) equal opportunity for and treatment of eligible bidders; (b) equitable distribution of rights and obligations between borrowers and bidders; and (c) credible mechanisms for addressing procurement-related complaints and providing recourse. ADB encourages open competition as the preferred procurement approach, whenever possible, to maximize fairness of the opportunity to bid.
Transparency	The principle of transparency means ensuring, through appropriate documentation and review of activities in the procurement process, that (a) relevant procurement information is made publicly available to interested parties, in a consistent and timely manner, through readily accessible and widely available sources at no (or reasonable) cost; (b) appropriate reporting of procurement activity; and (c) use of confidentiality provisions in contracts only where justified.
Quality	This principle requires that the procurement arrangements ⁴ are structured to procure inputs and deliver outputs of appropriate standard in a timely and effective manner to achieve the project outcomes and development objectives, taking into account the context, risk, value, and complexity of procurement.
Value for money	This principle enables the borrower to obtain optimal benefits through effective, efficient, and economic use of resources by applying, as appropriate, the Core Procurement Principles and related considerations, which may include lifecycle costs and socioeconomic and environmental development objectives of the borrower. Price alone may not sufficiently represent value for money.

Tender process



Bidding Process

Single-Stage: One-Envelope Bidding

- **Step 1:** Bidders submit one envelope with both technical and price proposals
- **Step 2:** All bids are opened publicly at the specified time
- **Step 3:** Contract is awarded to the lowest evaluated responsive bidder

Single-Stage: Two-Envelope Bidding

- **Step 1:** Bidders submit two sealed envelopes (technical + price) in one outer envelope
- **Step 2:** Only technical proposals are opened and evaluated first; Non-compliant bids are rejected
- **Step 3:** Price proposals of compliant bids are opened publicly
- **Step 4:** Contract is awarded to the lowest evaluated responsive bidder

Two-Stage Bidding

Stage 1

- **Step 1:** Bidders submit technical proposals (no prices)
- **Step 2:** Technical proposals are evaluated and discussed
- **Step 3:** Bidders revise proposals to meet required standards

Stage 2

- **Step 4:** Bidders submit revised technical + price proposals
- **Step 5:** Both are opened publicly and evaluated
- **Step 6:** Contract is awarded to the lowest evaluated responsive bidder (with ADB approval)

Expression of Interest (EOI)

- Company/group of firms' profile, organisation and staffing
- Details of previous project experience or similar assignments particularly undertaken in the previous five years, including information on contract value, contracting entity/client, project location/country, duration (mm/yy to mm/yy), expert months provided (if different from duration) , main activities, objectives.
- CVs of key experts who could carry out the Assignment detailing qualifications, experience in similar assignments, particularly assignments undertaken in the previous five years, including information on contracting entity/client, project location/country, duration (mm/yy to mm/yy), expert months provided, assignment budget, main activities, objectives.
- Completed Consultant Declaration Form and Contact Sheet

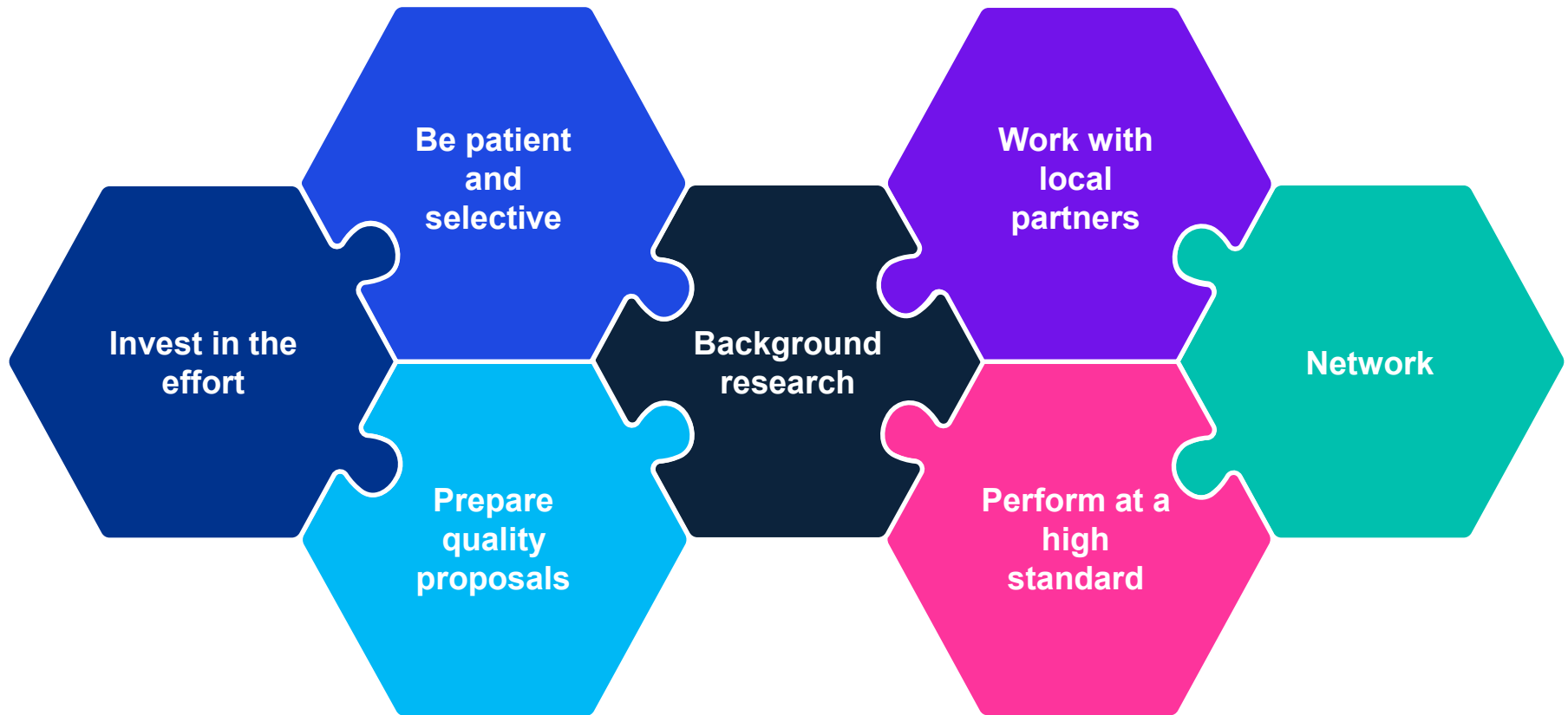
